I, _____, recognize the importance of this special time of preparation for Confirmation. I understand that this is a process of discernment in which I will:

- + Seek a closer relationship with God and with my peers in the group
- + Develop a better understanding of the Lutheran Church
- + Grow in faith, ponder difficult life questions, and be open to God
- + To continue the covenant God made in Holy Baptism (discipleship)
- + To live among God's faithful people (fellowship)
- + To hear God's word and share in God's supper (worship)
- + To proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed (evangelism)
- + To serve all people following the example of our Lord Jesus (ministry)

In order to accomplish this, to the best of my ability and with God's help, I commit to:

- + Glorify God with my life
- + Respect, honor and grow with those in my community of faith and my Confirmation class
- + Participate in my community of faith by asking questions and actively listening to others
 - *At the end of my studies I will share my experience with the community creatively through a Faith Project and participate in a Confirmation Interview with the pastor*
- + Attend class weekly / attend day and weekend retreats
 - *Missed classes must be made up by completing a 40 word reflection on the topic or Key Bible verse from the missed lesson; missed retreats must be made up by completing a large project on the topic from the event*
- + Worship regularly with my family and my confirmation family
 - *Completing 16 Worship Notes in my Confirmation notebook each year, half of which can be "Service Notes" earned by volunteering*
- + Honor my parents and communicate with them throughout this process
