Exhortation and Prayer of Dedication:

P. The Lord God is his goodness has blessed us with 125 years of mission and ministry as Our Savior's Lutheran Church. We are a remembering people, and it is good that we remember that God has chosen us, baptized us, and brought us together as the Church of Christ in this place.
