Call to Worship

L: We worship the God who created the heavens and the earth.

C: When finished creating, God smiled and said, "It is good!"

- C: May we hear God's holy laughter today.
- L: The Lord has done great things for us.
- C: Our hearts are filled with joy and our mouths with laughter.

C: We have come together today to have a good time and to laugh in the name of the Lord.

L: We come to worship the God of joy and gladness!

- L: For God has burst the bonds of sorrow. Life has crushed the power of death.

- L: The daughters and sons of God are lifted up; Christ has risen!

Blessing/Sending


L: Oh God, on Easter the thunder of your voice or perhaps it was your laughter that caused the stone to roll away from Christ's tomb.
