



<sup>10</sup>The LORD sits enthroned above the flood; the LORD sits enthroned as king forevermore.


<sup>11</sup>O LORD, give strength to your people; give them, O LORD, the blessings of peace.

They answered, "Into John's baptism." <sup>4</sup>Paul said, "John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in the one who was to come after him, that is, in Jesus." <sup>5</sup>On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. <sup>6</sup>When Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied—<sup>7</sup>altogether there were about twelve of them.




Lord, remember us in your kingdom and teach us to pray.
